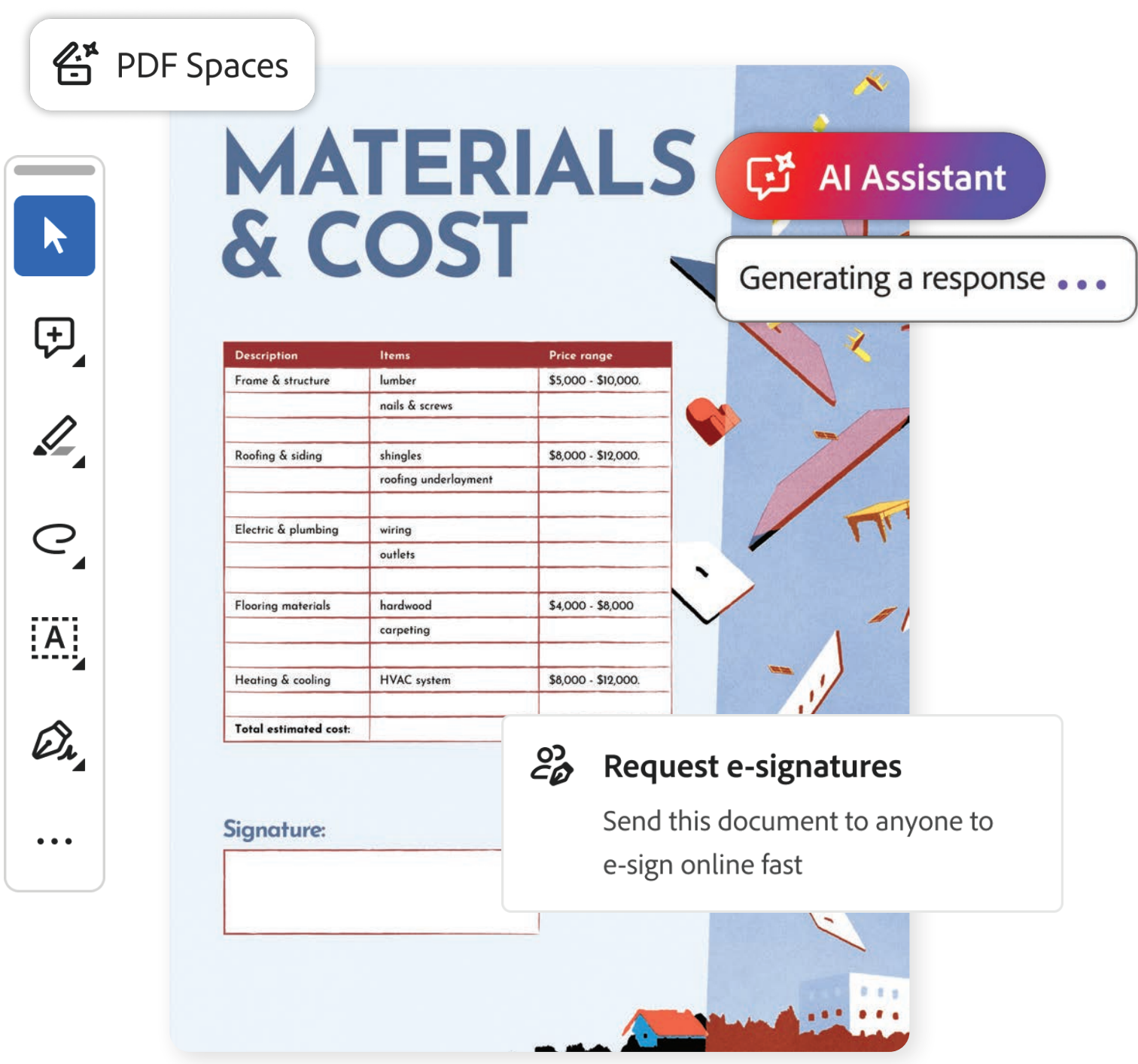
1 Eliminate siloed applications and consolidate platforms.

IT ops can add, manage, and assign licenses in a single admin dashboard.

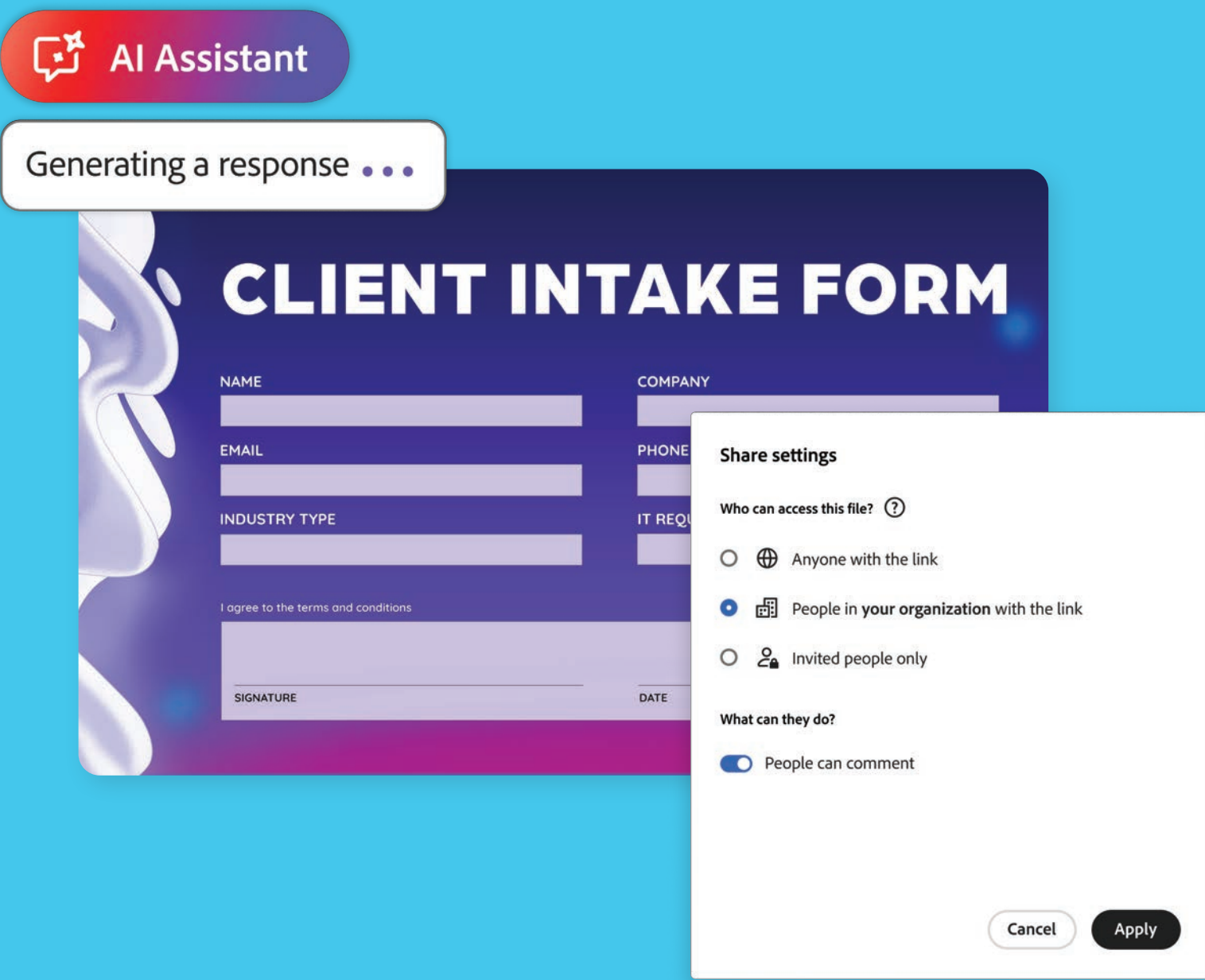


3 Check the box on security and compliance.

Bring your own AI—a.k.a. BYOAI—can create security risks for organizations. Adobe helps IT teams build trust in generative AI.

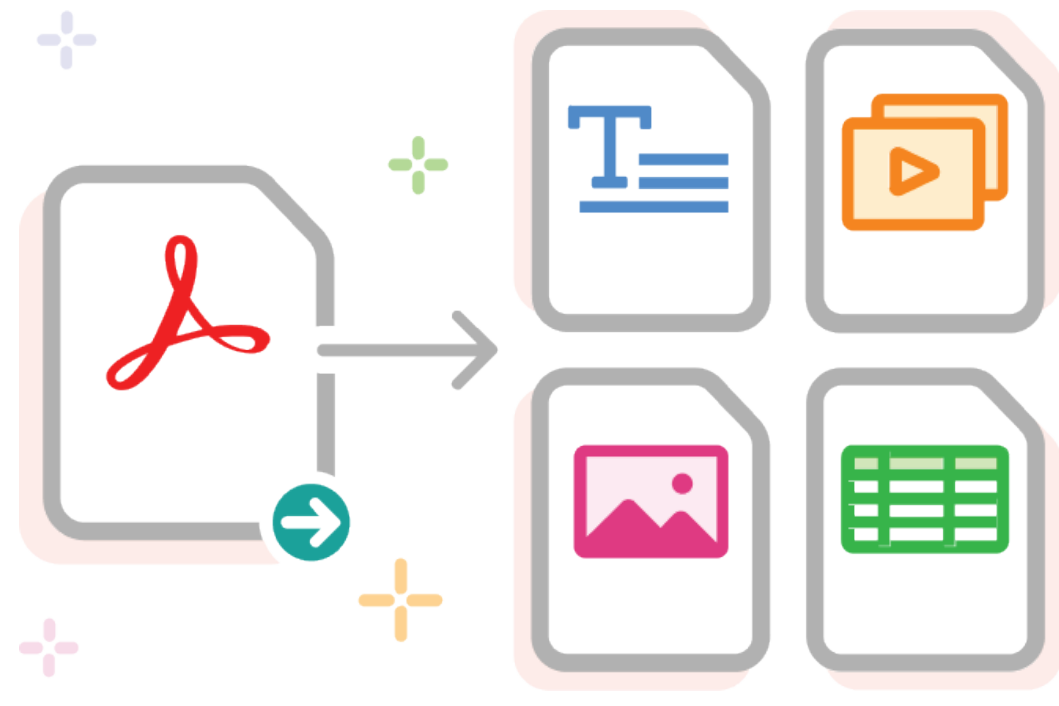
